

Paimarie Statement of Responsibilities

Lakes DHB reserves the right to immediately terminate your contract should you fail to meet any of the following responsibilities:

- Comply with the full list of expected behaviours, as outlined in the Lakes DHB Statement of Responsibilities, displayed in each unit.
- Ensure that all children are accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Please note that visitors are not permitted to stay in the Paimarie unit.
- Rotorua hospital is a **SMOKEFREE** site therefore **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING** is permitted anywhere on the hospital grounds or in the Paimarie facility. ***(Breach of this rule will lead to instant termination of this contract)***
- No illegal substances (e.g DRUGS) or alcohol are permitted anywhere on the hospital grounds or in the Paimarie facility. ***(Breach of this rule will lead to instant termination of this contract)***
- You need to be responsible for your own personal belongings and safety.
- Gang patches and paraphernalia are not permitted on any Lakes DHB site, and this includes the Paimarie units.
- All rooms must be left in a reasonable condition of cleanliness and repair. You will be charged for wilful damage to equipment or furniture in the units, or equipment / furniture that is missing from the unit following your stay. If the unit requires additional cleaning you may face extra charges.

Paimarie Whānau Accommodation

Rotorua Hospital services a wide area, and many of our patients come from out of town. We understand how crucial it can be to a patient's recovery that they are surrounded by loved ones, so Lakes DHB is committed to providing temporary, comfortable and affordable accommodation to the support person(s) of inpatients at Rotorua hospital, somewhere so they can be close to the patient and still have somewhere to rest and have a break.

What does Paimarie offer?

Paimarie Whānau Accommodation provides temporary emergency self-contained accommodation for close family/whānau support. The facility consists of 5 units, each equipped with basic cooking facilities and linen. There are also free laundry facilities located at the end of unit 5 for all occupants to use.

Where is Paimarie?

Paimarie Whānau Accommodation is conveniently located on-site at the back of the Rotorua hospital. (See map of Rotorua hospital site next page.)

Who can stay in Paimarie?

Family/whānau support of inpatients at Rotorua Hospital are eligible to stay at Paimarie provided they do not live in the Rotorua region, or do not have relatives or friends in the Rotorua area they can stay with.

To be eligible for accommodation:

- You must be the support person to an inpatient admitted to Rotorua Hospital
- You must also live further than 25 km from the hospital
- You must be able to pay in advance or qualify for National Travel Assistance funding

Does it cost anything?

- The cost per unit is \$40 per night.
- Payments can be made by eftpos or cash.
- There is no deposit required as payment is to be made daily in advance for each night.

How can you access this accommodation?

Please refer to the back of this brochure for contact details or speak to the hospital support staff (e.g. Hunga Manaaki, social workers or ward staff).

Check in and Check Out Times

CheckIN time is 2.30pm daily Monday - Friday (except public holidays). The coordinator will meet you at the front reception of the hospital.

Outside of these hours requests are to be made to the Duty Manager please see the back of this brochure for contact details.

CheckOUT time is 11.00am daily. If you have agreed to vacate the units on a particular day you must hand in your key and leave before this time or face an extra charge.
